



**Rector's Order Nr. 11/2020**  
**The introduction of distance education and special working hours in order to decrease the risks of COVID-19 infection**

With regard to the Rector's Order Nr. 6/2020; 8/2020; 10/2020 and their aims the present Rector's Order shall define the rules and guidelines the University of Miskolc (hereby referred to as University) shall follow in order to prevent the further spread of the Covid-19 infection.

The present order shall be binding on all departments of the University and all lecturers, researchers, staff and students of the University.

### **Education**

1. From the date of the order entering into force the University will continue its educational tasks in the form of distance learning. All forms of lectures, seminars, consultations and practical courses shall be offered in online – if it is possible. If a given course cannot be offered online the dean of the given faculty (or head of the institute in the case of the BBZI) may give permission to have contact courses. In such case the Rector shall be informed.
2. During the term the departments have the right to decide on the forms of in-term exams. Please take the guidelines of the present Rector's Order into account. During the finals (examination period) in-person exams can be held if the department is able to follow the rules of safe conduct strictly.
3. Sport activities offered as part of the schedule shall be cancelled. The absence of students is justified.

### **Restriction on events**

1. All events are cancelled at the University.
2. The number of in-person meetings shall be minimized. I ask all departments and units to prefer electronic ways of communication.



### **Dormitories**

1. Students are allowed to remain in the dormitories only if they are healthy and do not have any signs of COVID-19 infection.
2. Students staying in the dormitories shall follow the guidelines and regulations of the head of the dormitories. In the case of sickness, please inform the head of the dormitory immediately and remain in the allocated room until further notice.
3. The head of the dormitories shall inform the students immediately on any special actions or measures taken.

### **Miscellaneous**

1. The University does everything in its power to prevent the further spread of the COVID-19. Please note that only healthy persons who do not show any symptoms of the COVID-19 infection may enter the buildings of the University.
2. The wearing of protective masks is mandatory at the premises of the University, both indoors and outdoors!
3. The library and the sport facilities operate in accordance with the regulations regarding the pandemic situation.
4. Should there be any changes in the pandemic situation I will notify the University immediately. Please follow all communication platforms of the University!

The present Rector's Order enters into force on the 9<sup>th</sup> of November, 2020 and – without further notice – remains in force until the end of the semester, i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> of January, 2021.
