

Call for application

Within the framework of the Pannónia Scholarship Programme, the University of Miskolc announces a call for application for student mobilities.

Application deadline: continuous until the funds are exhausted, depends on the partner institutions acceptance of the mobility request

For self-paying students:

Long-term student mobility:

Currently, applications can only be submitted for mobilities starting after September 1.

- ***mobility for studies (2-5 months):*** for students of bachelor, master, undivided, and doctoral programmes, with a minimum of one completed semester.
- ***Traineeship (2 months):*** for students of higher-level vocational training, bachelor, master, undivided and doctoral programmes, with a minimum of one completed semester.
Until further notice due to funding constraints traineeship mobility can be applied for 2 months, and traineeship for recent graduates is not eligible for application.
- ***mobility for research purposes (2 months):***
 - at the end of a bachelor's programme; in connection with the thesis course;
 - for students of undivided programmes with a minimum of seven completed semesters;
 - for students of master and doctoral level study programmes with one completed semester.

For all students (including SH), for SCYP students for max 10 days:

Applications can only be submitted for a maximum duration of 10 days until August 31, 2025.

- ***Short-term mobility for studies*** (2-10 days: for students of bachelor, master, undivided, and doctoral programmes, with a minimum of one completed semester.
- ***Short-term mobility for research*** (2-10 days)
 - at the end of a bachelor's programme; in connection with the thesis course;

- for students of undivided programmes with a minimum of seven completed semesters;
- for students of master and doctoral level study programmes participation is possible from the first semester of studies.

Application requirements:

- Students must be active students during both the application and mobility periods.
- Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holder students can apply only for short-term mobility, up to a maximum of 30 days.
- SCY scholarship students can apply for up to a maximum of 10 days.

Application process

Submitting the application at least two weeks before the planned mobility is recommended. Students can apply for the Pannonia Scholarship Programme by filling out the [Online Application form](#) with the certificate of active student status and the fully signed Learning or Mobility agreement:

- **Learning Agreement** for mobility for studies
- **Mobility Agreement** for traineeship and research

Credit transfer:

The activities completed during the mobility must be recognised by the sending institution and fully comply with the structure of the curriculum on a proportional basis to the duration of the student's mobility.

Partner institutions:

Pannonia mobility for studies can be realized under any bilateral agreement (Pannonia, Erasmus+, MoU), if the partner accepts the student mobility with the Pannonia Learning document.

The Pannonia bilateral agreements are in the process of being signed with the current partner institutions, the regularly updated list is available from the application form.

Institutional bilateral agreement is not required for the following types of mobility:

- mobility for research purposes,
- traineeship,
- short term mobility for studies with active conference participation,
- short-term mobility for studies not in a higher education institution.
