Reconnecting with the EU: Matchmaking and Networking Partner Meeting – University of Miskolc

The University of Miskolc is pleased to invite its European partner institutions to a two-day professional meeting aimed at revitalizing existing collaborations and exploring new joint research opportunities.

In light of recent developments, our university is expected to regain full access to European Union research and innovation funding under the 2021–2027 framework. This creates an important window of opportunity for renewed cooperation: in the coming months, we must use this regained access to design high-impact projects that can make effective use of the available budget, in close cooperation with our trusted partners. We believe that strong, well-prepared consortia with Hungarian participation can now enhance the competitiveness of proposals and contribute to further strengthening of the Central and Eastern European innovation landscape.

We would like to use this opportunity to reconnect with our partners, review ongoing research activities, share recent results, and identify areas where synergies can lead to new joint projects.
